Bring a picnic rug and hamper and relax.



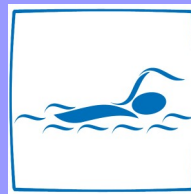
## WHAT HAVE WE BEEN LEARNING?

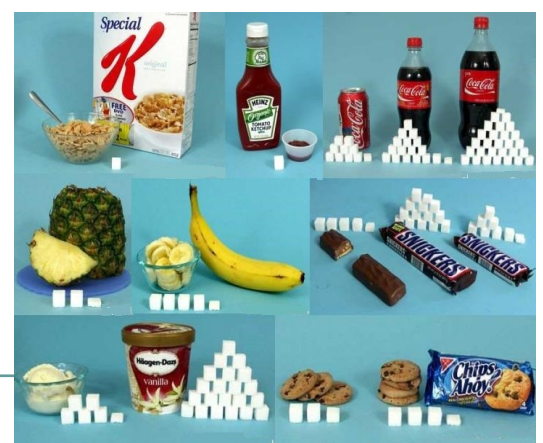

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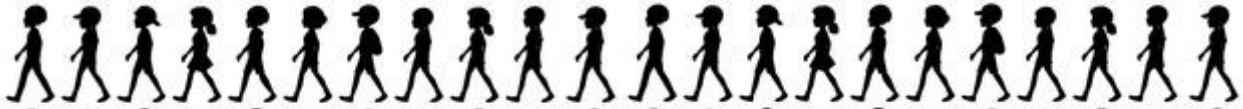
