## From the Principal's Desk Jackie Annable



*A student who is half an hour late each day misses the equivalent of 16.6 days learning each year! That is more than 3 weeks learning, approximately a third of a Term!*

**Soup Club:** As the weather begins to cool I am excited to tell you that we are going to be able to offer cups of warming soup to all students every Tuesday at lunch time starting next week. There is no cost for the soup and there will be a vegetarian and gluten free option available for students with dietary needs. This program has been made possible through a partnership with the Rye Community House, a volunteer chef, Jill Midlovets, hospitality students from Chisholm TAFE and Rye Primary School. Where possible, ingredients are sourced from donations.

Jill has trialled this project on the Westernport side of the Peninsula, offering soup to a number of schools there. She has approached us at Rye to be a trail school on the Bayside of the Peninsula.

Initially we will serve the soup in bio pack, double insulated, lidded cups but ideally we would like to purchase cups that can be washed and reused. The cost of the cups and containers to store them in is \$1500. If you have a local business or know of anyone who has, and would be interested in joining this community initiative through sponsorship, I would love to hear from you.
