## Ride To School

## Numeracy

Over the last couple of weeks, students have completed pre assessments in the area of Number during numeracy sessions. We have been working on their knowledge of decimals, place value and the four operations of addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. Pre assessments inform teachers of a student's existing knowledge and support teachers in providing differentiated learning to cater to all learning needs in the classroom.

We have also been investigating everyday language and everyday situations where the four processes are used.



## Writing

Students have been learning to develop their vocabulary and use descriptive writing to allow the reader to imagine and visualise the details of the scene they are setting. They have also been working on their excellent editing skills to make their writing more interesting.

We looked at some deleted scenes from famous Disney films and discussed the reasons why they were deleted. Students have used their excellent editing skills to make their own pieces of writing more interesting by 'Banning the Boring Bits.' Students are loving their writing sessions and they are producing some amazing work!

## Sailing

Grade 6's have been having a fantastic time learning the skills of sailing over the last 4 weeks with some students moving on from the Opti and sailing on a Pacer and a Laser. Next week



is our last week of sailing and students will be given details about applying for a Sailing Scholarship for the 2018/19 season with Rye Yacht Club.
