



Parental Controls on Television

As our young children grow and become more mature there comes a time when as parents, we have to decide what is and what isn't appropriate for our children to watch on television including web-based video streaming like YouTube, Foxtel and Netflix. It's important that parents are aware of what their child/children are watching on these platforms as some of these programs are not recommended nor suitable for children under the age of 15 years of age. Parental Controls are a useful tool in helping to keep our children safe and to protect them from viewing shows that are not mentally healthy nor appropriate for their age. There are many apps and gadgets that parents can investigate/use to limit access to age appropriate viewing.
